2829 Buena Vista Way, Berkeley

This three bedroom, three bath sanctuary showcases elegant details and the endless cityscape it overlooks from its perch in the Berkeley hills. Originally designed by Architect Ian Mackinlay and built in 1962, it has been recently renovated and crafted into a home with confident sophistication. Modern details and quality materials make this an understated classic that will withstand fluctuating trends. Upon walking in the door, one is immediately greeted by a spacious great room. The vaulted ceilings are highlighted by beams that create an unbroken line from indoors to outdoors and continue over the cantilevered deck. These draw the eye to a magnificent view that extends from the Bay Bridge to the Golden Gate Bridge and beyond. This inspiring vista is on display throughout the back of the home, including all three bedrooms, the great room and the kitchen. The open kitchen features granite counters, glass mosaic inlays and a six-burner gas stove. A few steps from the great room is a bedroom/study with built-ins and an adjacent full bath with opalescent mosaic tiles, a glass vanity and sink. On the lower level, each of the two bedroom suites have private decks that gaze onto the greenery of the surrounding neighborhood and out to the San Francisco skyline, the Bay Bridge, and the Golden Gate. Enjoy all of these features in a home designed for privacy.
